1. Information We Collect

We only collect personal information explicitly provided by parents/guardians during the student intake process. This includes Parent name, email address, child's age, and learning/accessibility needs. Inside the Minecraft environment, we do not log, track, or harvest player metrics beyond standard server connection logs.

2. How Data is Utilized and Protected

Because LERE Academy utilizes secure, organization-managed Microsoft 365 accounts, student data is sandboxed within our private domain. We use your data strictly to manage server access and communicate class schedules. We maintain a zero-sharing policy: your data is never sold, traded, or distributed to third parties.

3. Parental Control and Data Deletion

Parents retain absolute control over their child's digital footprint. You have the right to review the information we hold, request corrections, or instruct us to permanently delete your child's data and Microsoft account from our system at any time by emailing admin@lere-academy.org.
